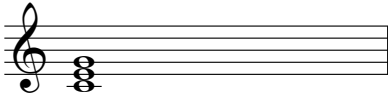

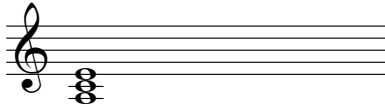

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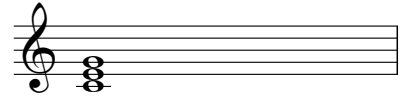
Example 1. C Major triad



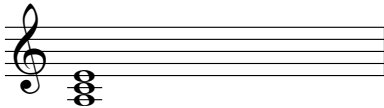
Example 2. A minor triad



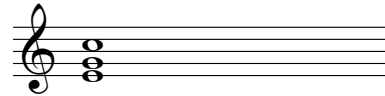
Example 3. C Major root position



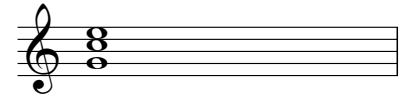
Example 4. A minor root position



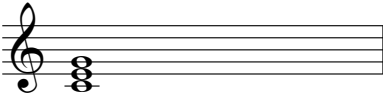
Example 5 C Major 1st inversion



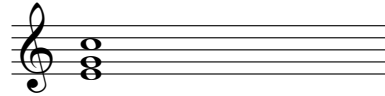
Example 6 C Major 2nd inversion



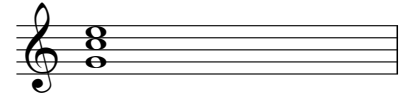

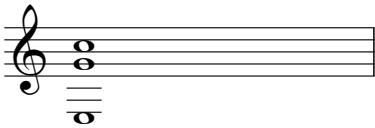

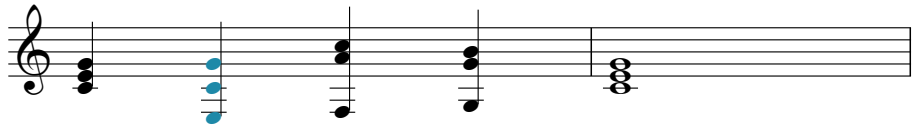

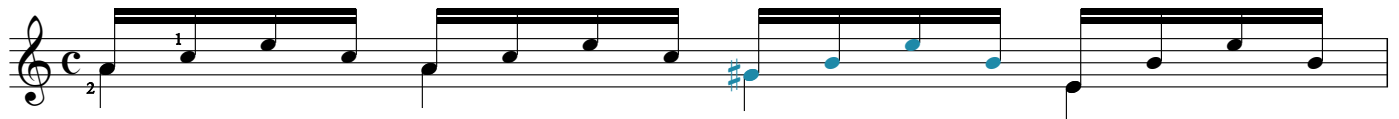
